#### 2017 MEN'S LEAGUE RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. <u>Day, Time & Tees:</u> All regular Men's League events will be played on Wednesday. The set of tee players play are to be determined. Men's League tee times will be held between 12:30pm and 3:00pm.
- 2. Flights: To Be Determined
- 3. <u>Membership and Event Fees</u>: The membership fee for Men's League is \$35. To play in Men's League events, participants MUST have a valid USGA handicap. A handicap maintained at Eagle Ranch Golf Club is an additional annual fee of \$40.00. The event fee for each week is \$10 cash, plus an optional fee for gross and net skins at \$5 cash each.
- 4. <u>Greens Fee</u>: The greens fees for the Men's League are: \$35.00 Value Season, \$42.00 Shoulder Season and Peak Season. Golf Cart is an additional \$18 per person.
- 5. <u>Sign-Up Procedure</u>: Participants may book tee times for Men's League seven days or less in advance. Participants can start signing up Wednesday a week prior to the event. The deadline to sign up by is 10:00am on Wednesday the day of league. Please call (328-2882 ext.1) or stop by the golf shop to make your tee time.
- 6. <u>Cancellations and No-Shows</u>: Participants must cancel by 10:00am on Wednesday the day league. Late cancellations or no-shows will be given a warning. Significant amount of no-shows or last minute cancellation will result in a Men's League expulsion.
- 7. Pace of Play: Every player is responsible for their group's pace of play. It is the Eagle Ranch Golf Club Player Assistant's job to monitor that pace and inform a group when they are behind pace. Slow groups in Men's League will be given the proper notice / warning that their group is behind pace. If proper warning is given and pace is not improved in the time allowed, the entire group will be penalized.
- 8. <u>Rules & Etiquette</u>: All Men's League events will be played following USGA Rules. It is each player's responsibility to have a basic understanding of the rules. The Eagle Ranch Professional Staff will act as the rules committee for each event. Proper golf etiquette is expected of each Men's League participant. Eagle Ranch reserves the right to suspend any member's privileges for improper conduct on the course or at the clubhouse.
- 9. <u>Handicaps</u>: The Eagle Ranch Professional Staff will monitor all Men's League members' handicaps to help ensure all scores are entered properly. A 40 handicap is the max handicap for any Men's League participant, suggested by the USGA. Men's League scores will be entered into the system by Eagle Ranch staff. DO NOT ENTER YOUR OWN MEN'S LEAGUE SCORE IN THE GHIN COMPUTER.
- 10. <u>Guests</u>: You may invite a guest to play in any regular Wednesday Men's League event. Your guest MUST have a current valid USGA handicap and must also pay a \$20 event fee (instead of the \$10) in addition to the Men's League green fee. Please provide your guest's GHIN number when you reserve your tee time. Any guest can only play in ONE Men's League event without being a league member, after that he will have to pay the annual Men's League fee.



#### **Special Men's League Events**

- 11. <u>Club Championship</u>: September 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup>. To be eligible to play in the Club Championship, you must be a paid member of Men's League and played in at least <u>FIVE</u> Men's League events throughout the season. NO EXCEPTIONS. You must also have posted at least ten 18 hole scores in the GHIN system from September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 to September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017.
- 12. <u>Match Play Championship</u>: All Men's League Members are eligible to play in the season long Match Play Championship. Participants can choose from 2 divisions; Low Gross only (played from the gold tees) or low Net only (played from the blue tees). You MUST have a valid and current USGA handicap to play in the low Net divisions. The low gross division will be played *Straight Up* without giving or receiving any strokes.
- 13. The Rodeo 2-Man Team Event: July 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup>. The Rodeo is designed to be our Member-Member/ Member-Guest Tournament. So, participants may play with another Men's League Member, but is preferred to invite an outside guest to play in this event. Both players MUST have a valid and current USGA handicap to play in this event, NO EXCEPTIONS. The Rodeo will begin on Friday evening with registration and a 9-hole 4-person scramble. The Friday evening event is optional for participants. The format of play will consist of a 2-Man Best Ball on Saturday and a 2-Man Modified Alternate Shot on Sunday.
- 14. The Shootout Challenge: If you got game (or at least think you do) come and sign up for this event. Participant will be teeing off from the black tees up to the white tees. Individual teeing grounds will be determined by the individual's handicap. A shootout follows until there is one man standing. Come challenge your PGA professional staff!!!
- 15. Player of the Year: Each year the best gross and net player will receive a plaque/trophy. Each week the top 8 gross and net players earn points towards Player of the Year. This is NOT flighted and an individual can win points in both gross and net. The point system works like this: 1st place gets 10 points, 2nd place gets 8 points, 3rd place gets 6 points, 4th place get 5 points, 5th place gets 4 points, 6th place gets 3 points, 7th place gets 2 points, and 8th place gets 1 points. If there is a tie the point will be divided evenly going to the tenth decimal. At the end of the year whoever has the most gross points will receive the gross plaque/trophy and whoever has the most net points will receive the net plaque/trophy.
